District Judge Patti B. Saris: **ELECTRONIC ORDER** entered. Defendants have moved to modify certain aspects of the notice requirements in the Court's partial final judgment issued on December 19, 2025 (Dkt. 116). The motion is **ALLOWED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**. Defendants shall serve the notice on as many class members already in immigration detention as possible by January 9, 2026. By January 12, 2026, Defendants shall file a status report describing their efforts to serve the notice on the existing class members, explaining the steps necessary to serve the notice on any remaining class members, and proposing a prompt timeline for completing the service of notice on existing class members. As for the provision of telephone access, the Court modifies its order to require Defendants to provide the noncitizen with access to a telephone to call an attorney as soon as possible, and no later than three hours, after the noncitizen receives the notice.(LP)
