I believe only Somerset, Cumberland and possibly Two Bridges correctional facilities house federal inmates. We only house those who have been charged with crime and require an affidavit in support of the probable cause to hold them for 48 hours.

• Any policies or procedures related to holding individuals for CBP/ICE, including any policies or procedures related to ICE detainers.
